



**History & Geography-**

**NC** – name and locate counties and cities in the United Kingdom .

**Sound**

**NC** – To explore and identify how sounds are made through vibrations.

- Children will be identifying how sounds are made, while looking at vibrations.
- They will find patterns between pitch, volume and the sounds produced from these.

**English – Talk for Writing**

- This term children will be continuing to work with the Talk for Writing scheme. They will be looking at two different texts and really exploring the texts through drama and discussion. Children will have opportunities to write in a range of different non-fiction genres.
