From Friday 18th September you will be invited to join 'Google Classroom.' Previous classes have been archived and you will need to join your new class using the new class code. Passwords have also been reset.

Weekly homework will be issued through Google Classroom so you will need to log in at least every week to complete the tasks set. Your teachers will check your work when you have completed it. We will also use Google Classroom sometimes during Computing lessons in school.

You will be able to talk to your teachers through Google Classroom but we have disabled comments and posts on the feed so you concentrate on your school work rather than chat. You can still add comments to your own work. Remember, whatever you write will be seen by your teachers as well as Mrs Snowden, Mrs Pearce, Mrs Kearney, Mr Jones. If you need help with something you can send a private message to your teacher.

It is important that we use Google Classroom safely and respectfully. Here are our rules:

- 1. All our WHA Values apply online as they do in the playground or in school.
- 2. Use kind words, to each other and to adults. Do not write anything offensive, rude or unkind.
- 3. Make sure that what you write is respectful and appropriate. Only write down things you would be happy to say to your teachers and friends if you were in school. Don't write private things that you do not want everyone to know.
- 4. Double check and re-read everything you write before you press 'send', 'post' or 'hand in'.

You will also be able to use the Google tools and apps available including docs, sheets, slides, drive etc., but not Gmail. Your Google account and email address can only be used within the WHA school domains and addresses ending **@whatpfat.com** and **@theparkfederation.org**
