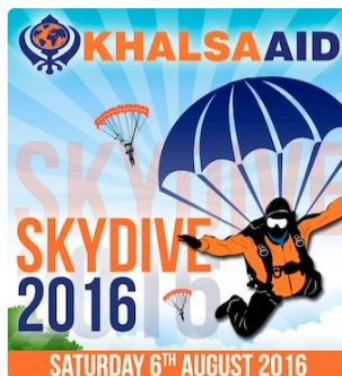


Stranded Motorists in Dover
