We cover diagnostic criteria, the assessment process and how a well-informed response can improve communication and behaviour. We will also give you tips and strategies that you can put into place while you are waiting for the appointment.

Sessions are delivered by autism professionals who are also parents of young people on the autism spectrum and are open to anyone living in East Berkshire who has a child on the waiting list for an ASD assessment.
