

Read with a child....

*it's the most important
20 minutes of your day.*

Child "A"
reads for **20 minutes**
every day.
That's 3,600 minutes
in a school year.

Child "B"
reads for **5 minutes**
every day.
That's 900 minutes
in a school year.

Child "C"
reads for **1 minute**
every day.
That's 180 minutes
in a school year.



By the end of Year 6, Child "A" will have read the equivalent of 60 whole school days. Child "B" will have read only 12 school days.
