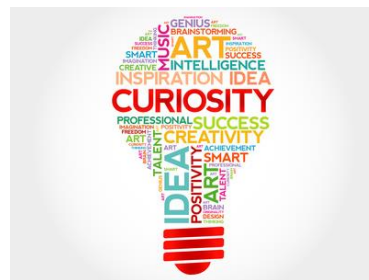


Year 5 Weekly Update Friday 23rd November 2018

The value we are working on over the next few weeks is **Curiosity**. At Western House we want to develop learners who are curious about the world. We are linking this to our **PBL** work by exploring all aspects of the geography of the countries that make up Eastern Europe.



English:

We are now moving on to a new genre of writing in our English lessons. We are learning the skills of writing a Non-Chronological Report. The children have studied the features of this type of writing and are now applying the use of sub-titles and paragraphs to give the reader lots of information about subjects ranging from Elephants to the country of Slovakia.

Maths:

We are still working with Fractions in Maths this week. The process of multiplying fractions by a whole number before moving on to multiplying a fraction by another fraction.
